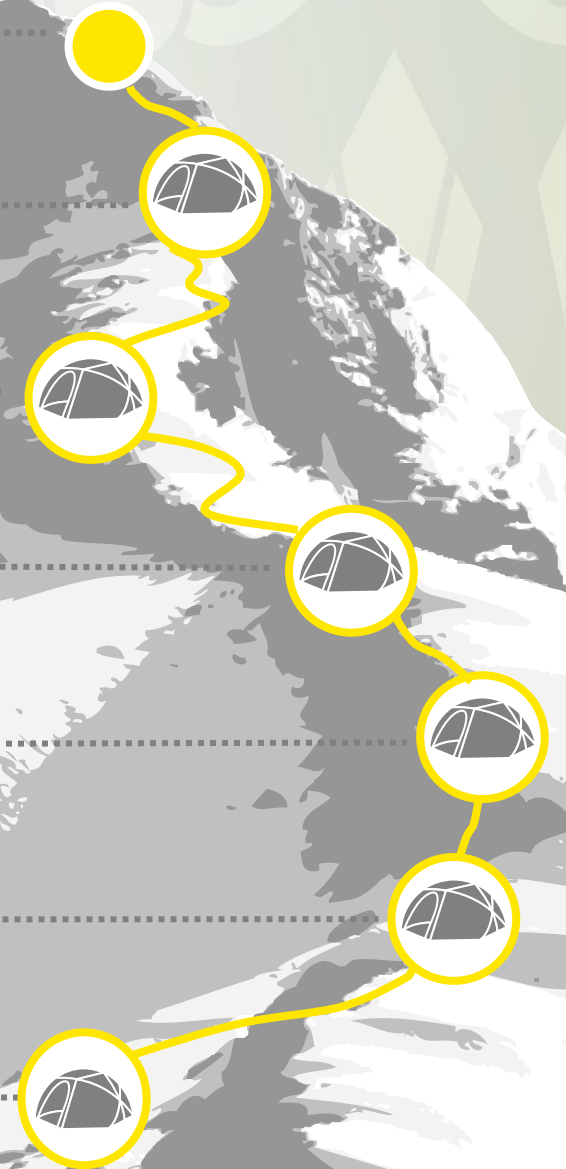

Potential next steps for UNEDAP members

Fostering national capacity development through UNEDAP evaluations

- presence of **national governments** in management structures
- foster **joint and country-led evaluations**
- use **national evaluation plans**, guidelines, standards
- strengthen the capacity of **local evaluators**, including through support to YEE

Continue to support the capacity development of national evaluation ecosystems

- support country-owned **M&E systems analysis**
- support the engagement of **senior policymakers** in the executive and parliament
- facilitate the engagement of **non-state actors** in the evaluation ecosystem

Further coordinate and collaborate

- ensure **inter-agency** information sharing, coordination and collaboration on NECD
- allocate more **time and resources**
- include NECD as an explicit part of **individual agency country programmes** and of the UNSDCF
