

## GCF's Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme (RPSP)

## RPSP's Five Objectives

1. Capacitybuilding for climate finance coordination

2. Strategies for climate finance implementation

3. NAPs, other adaptation planning processes

4. Paradigmshifting pipeline development

5. Knowledge sharing and learning

- Up to USD 1 million per country per year for support related to institutional capacity building, coordination, policy and planning, and programming for investment.
- Up to USD 3 million per country for formulating adaptation plans.
- Although the amount of the grant is small, the evaluation found some countries effectively use this GCF's grant to green their development policies (ex. NAP and country programing for climate change investment)







## Challenges/bottleneck

- LDCs and African States continue to face the most significant challenges in accessing GCF's Readiness support.
- For some key GCF stakeholders, the application process remains is overly demanding, costly, time-consuming and thus disproportionate to the support provided.
- The GCF's RPSP has supported organizational structures and policies for climate financing that will likely be sustained; however, a high turnover of government staff is a challenge
