## Cambodia: Mainstreaming Climate Resilience into Development Planning (2013-2021, \$11 million)

Policy support for climate change adaptation across 8 ministries to integrate climate within national planning, budgetary, and implementation processes

National Adaptation Program of Action (NAPA)

Strategic National Action Plan (SNAP) for DRR

Strategic Program for Climate Resilience (\$588 M, 7 investment projects)

Feasibility studies for NAPA projects

Civil society support mechanism
Capacity of NGOs and CSOs to mainstream
adaptation and DRR into their operations

- Tools and guidelines for climate risk management
- Enabling key ministries to screen development projects for climate risks and devise suitable adaptation policies and measures
- Effective monitoring of adaptation investments
