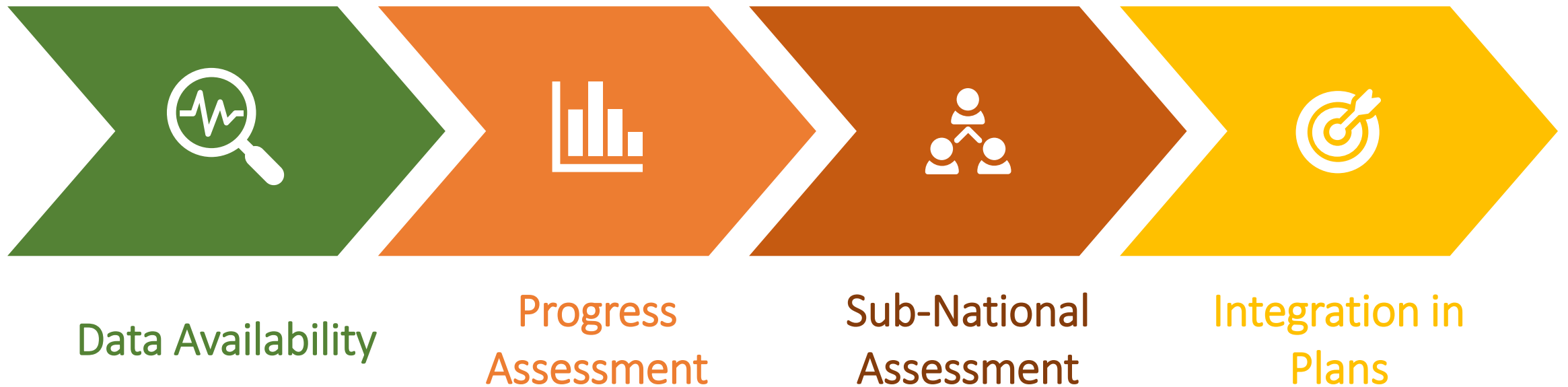

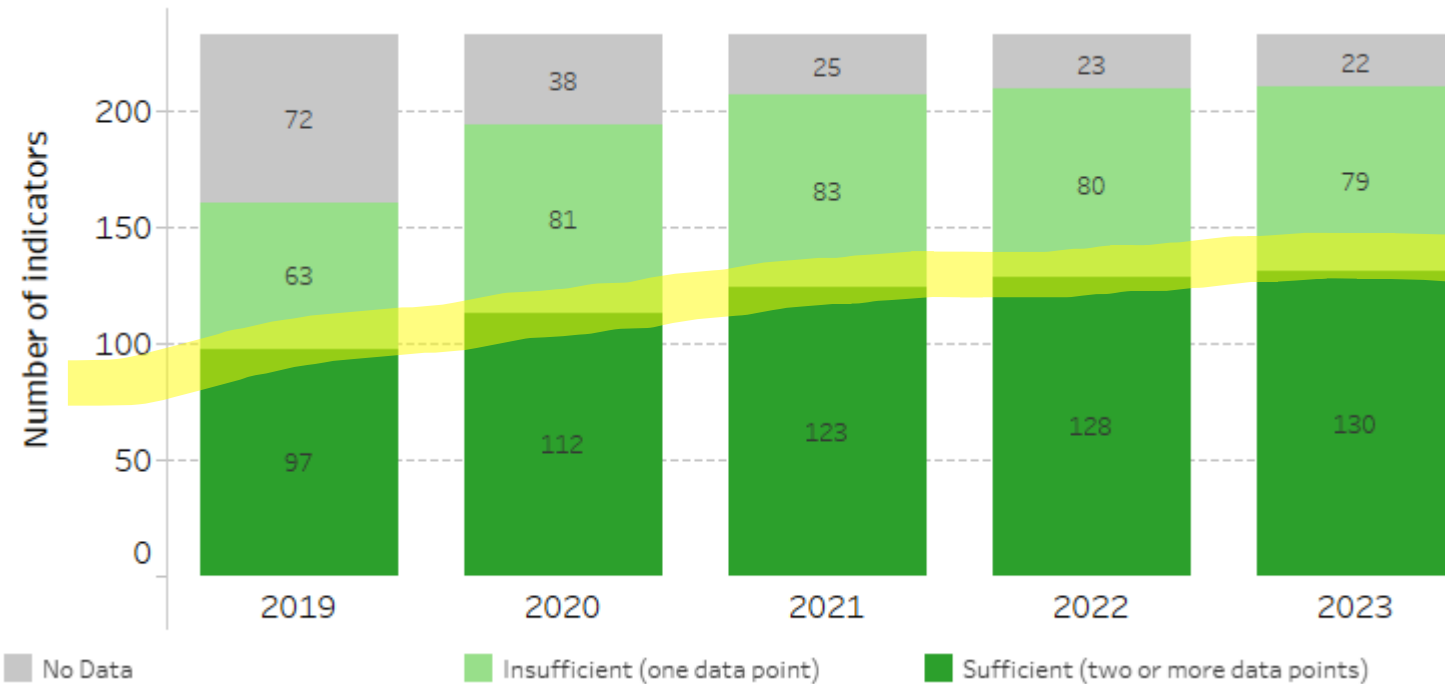

Availability of SDG data

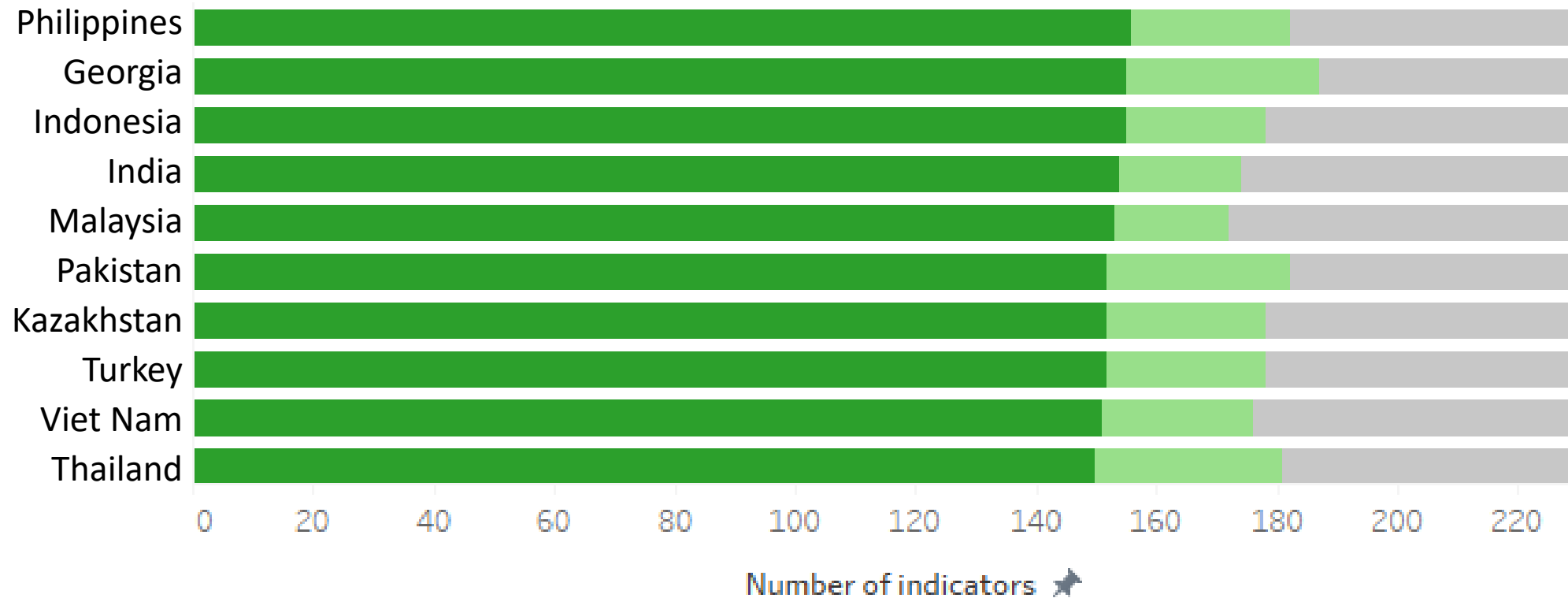
SDG data availability in Asia-Pacific



The momentum is slowing down

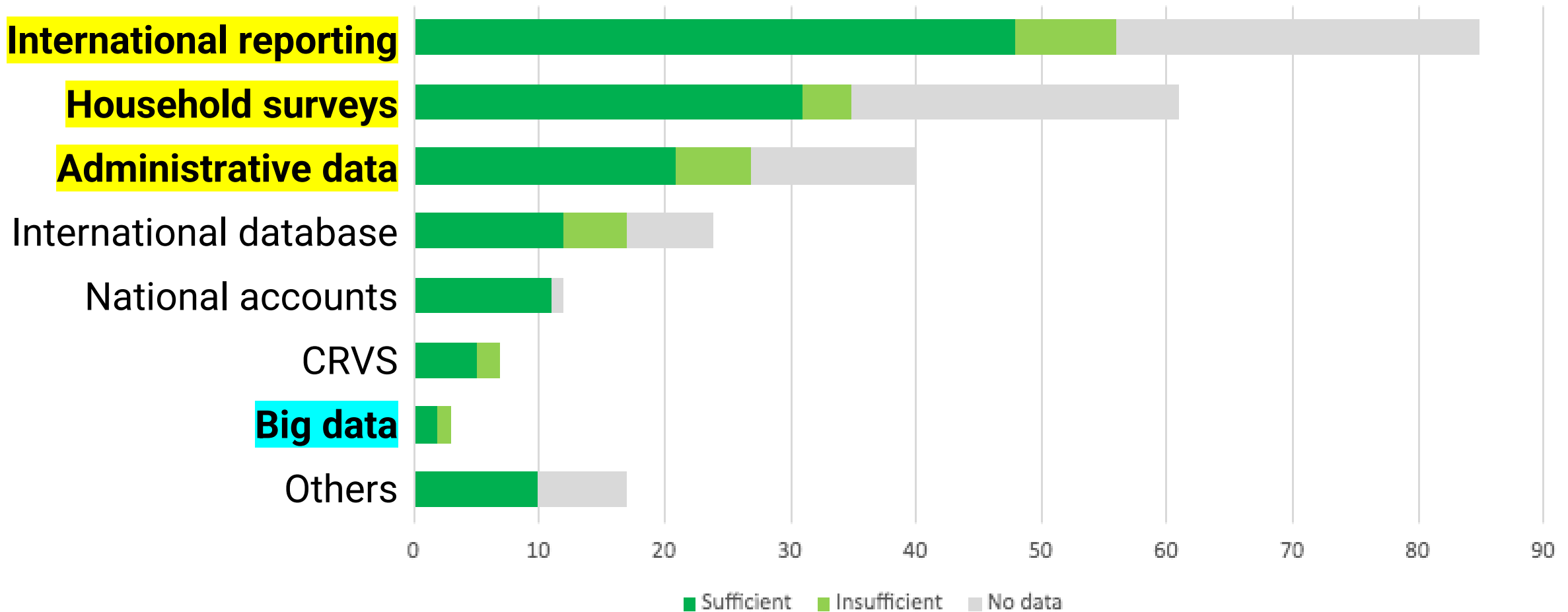

Top 10 member states in terms of SDG data availability in Asia-Pacific

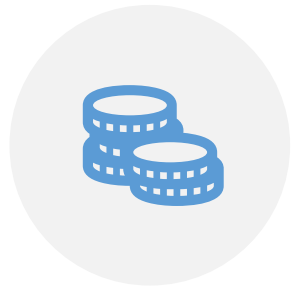

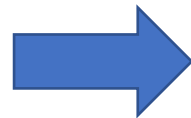
SDG Progress in Asia-Pacific 2023
